## Rules

1. Registration for the contest is \$5.00 per individual and \$15.00 per team if registered by March 10, 2017. Team registration after March 10, 2017 up until the day of the contest will be double the entry fee, \$10.00 per individual and \$30.00 per team. Pre-registration must be accompanied by a check or money order. **No purchase orders will be accepted.** Entries made onsite the day of the contest can also be paid in cash.
2. Teams do not have to be from the same county or chapter. Teams can consist of 3 or 4 people, the 3 highest scores count for the team placing.
3. All coaches who have provided self-addressed envelopes will be mailed results the week after the contest.
4. All participants should bring a clip board and No. 2 sharpened pencil.
5. Competitors will be allowed 12 minutes to evaluate each class.
6. While the contest is in progress there will be no conferring between contestants or between a contestant and anyone else except as directed by the group leader.
7. Animals will be numbered from left to right as viewed from the rear.
8. Coaches and parents are not allowed to mingle with contestants after the contest has officially started. If they are viewing the contest they must remain in the seating area. Only contestants and contest personnel are permitted in the judging area.
9. A perfect score in the placing of a class will consist of 50 points.
10. Determination of rating when scores are tied:
  - a. If tied, the contestant or team having the highest score on questions shall be listed first.
  - b. If still tied, the contestant or team having the highest placings scores on question classes shall be listed first.
  - c. If still tied, the discretion of the committee will be used to break all ties.
11. If questions concerning the interpretation of the rules arise, the decision of the judging contest committee shall prevail.
12. Questions will be asked orally at the conclusion of the judging portion of the contest. Students will not be receiving a list of questions to answer while judging, but rather will be answering the questions based on memory.
